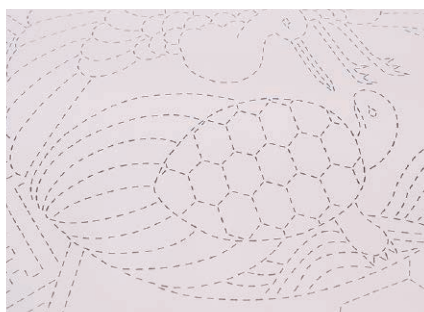
It can be divided and made into cushion covers.

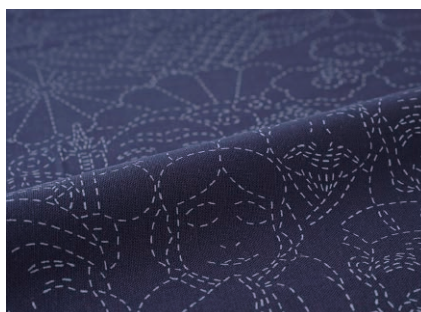
The pattern on the horns is a tassel to ward off evil spirits.
